

Church Repairs & Finance

The Parish Finance Council (12 parishioners from across the parish) met on Tuesday night to look at the costs involved with the repairs to both churches. It was felt that in the current economic circumstances of rising costs it would be difficult to raise the amount of money required for repairs and we will need to consider all the options including closing one church.

The group agreed to look at all the issues we could identify and produce a rational, rather than emotional assessment of our options including costs for urgent and future work on each site and the value of our properties so that we can make a decision as a parish to recommend to the Bishop a way forward.

It is important to stress that no decision has been made at this point and we will keep you up to date on our progress. We expect it will be the summer before we can gather all the information.
