Building Fabric & Finance

I mentioned at the end of last year a concern about the cracks around the parish hall at Sacred Heart. An initial engineers report last week has raised a number of concerns and the engineer also noticed similar signs around the house. We have therefore asked for a full structural survey of the house and hall to better understand the problems and confirm the initial findings. For the technically minded, the engineer thought that the facing brick was a calcium silicate brick that would require regular expansion joints that are missing on the house and hall. It was observed from the attic of the hall that there are no ties between the bricks in the cavity and also concerns around the safety and structure of the suspended ceiling in the main hall.

As we hope the Churches will reopen at the end of March/beginning of April I would then like to form two parish groups, a fabric group to advise on maintenance work and a finance group to consider how we best manage our resources to support the parish and maintain its buildings.
