Increased Church Capacity for Mass

You may have seen the news that churches can increase the numbers attending maintaining 2m physical distancing from 26 April. We will introduce different kinds of bookings for each church to increase the number able to attend, while it adds a degree of confusion it increases the available capacity. If everyone turns up as an individual for Mass our capacity will not increase greatly but family and household groups will make a significant difference to the capacity of the Churches. Those sitting together should be part of the same household. Our current plan is, subject to last minute alterations:

In Sacred Heart Church there will be the option to book a space for up to 2 people from the same household and the option to book a space for a household group of up to 5 people.

In St Gerard's Church there will be the option to book a space for one person and the option to book a space for a household group of up to 5 people.

If your household is bigger than 5 please speak to Fr Stuart who can explain the best way to make a booking.
